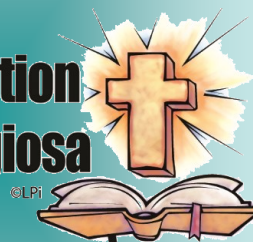

SAINT LAWRENCE, Martyr
(c. 225 - 258)
Patron Saint of archivists and librarians
Feast Day - August 10



Pope Sixtus ordained St. Lawrence as a deacon. During this time the Church was heavily persecuted by the Roman State. As Pope Sixtus was being led to execution, Lawrence followed him weeping, and said to him, "Father where are you going without your deacon?" Sixtus answered that he would be following him in three days and that now the treasures of the Church were in his care. Hearing the word 'treasures' the Prefect

of Rome commanded Lawrence to give him all the riches of the Church.

Now that Lawrence knew he would be arrested like the pope, he sought out the poor, the widows and the orphans of Rome and gave them all the money he had on hand, selling even the sacred vessels to increase the sum. Over the next three days Lawrence rounded up all the orphans, widows, lame and poor that the Church supported. He brought them to the Prefect and said, "Here are the treasures of the Church."

The Prefect was so angry he told Lawrence that he would indeed have his wish to die—but it would be by inches. He had a great gridiron prepared, with coals beneath it, and had Lawrence's body placed on it over the flames. After the martyr had burnt a while on one side, Lawrence told his captors, I am done on this side, flip me over!"

The created things of this world are not free of ownership: "For they are yours, O Lord, who love the living" (Wis 11:26). This is the basis of our conviction that, as part of the universe, called into being by one Father, all of us are linked by unseen bonds and together form a kind of universal family, a sublime communion which fills us with a sacred, affectionate and humble respect. Here I would reiterate that "God has joined us so closely to the world around us that we can feel the desertification of the soil almost as a physical ailment, and the extinction of a species as a painful disfigurement".
