## SAINT PATRICK (c. 387 – c. 461) Patron and Apostle of Ireland Feast Day – March 17th



Truth is best served by our seeing two solid qualities in him: he was humble and he was courageous. The determination to accept suffering and success with equal indifference guided the life of God's instrument for winning most of Ireland for

Christ.

When St. Patrick was a youth, he was kidnapped and taken to Ireland. As a slave for six years, he prayed by himself and grew in love for God. One night while he was asleep, he heard a voice preparing him to escape. He made his way back home (his birthplace may have been Scotland), but later understood through visions God's desire that he return to Ireland and teach the Irish the love of Christ.

To prepare, St. Patrick spent several years in Britain and France, and he is believed to have been consecrated bishop by St. Germanus. When he returned to Ireland, he traveled over the entire Island preaching, winning converts and working miracles – including raising the dead – all the while viciously opposed by Druids and chieftains.

St. Patrick alone baptized several thousands, ordained priests, consecrated virgins, educated children in the Christian Faith, relieved the poor and sent missionaries to other countries. Thus, in less than 30 years, St. Patrick not only converted Ireland to the One True Faith but also sowed the seeds of future conversions. Patrick was a man of action, with little inclination toward learning. He had a rocklike belief in his vocation.
