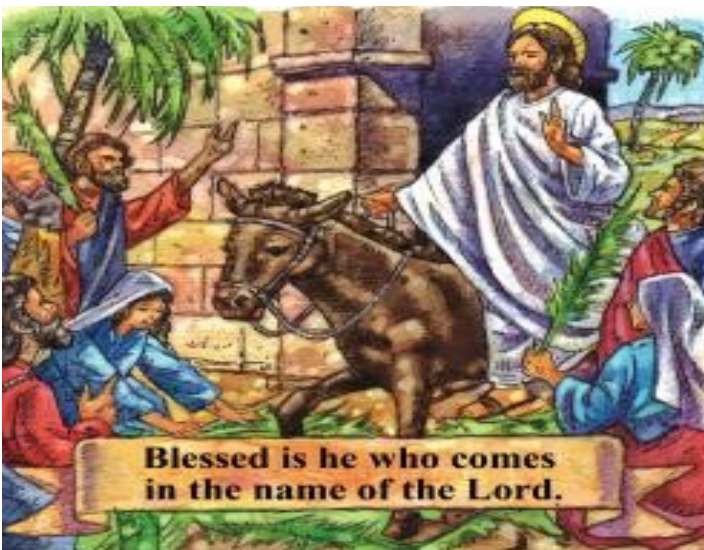

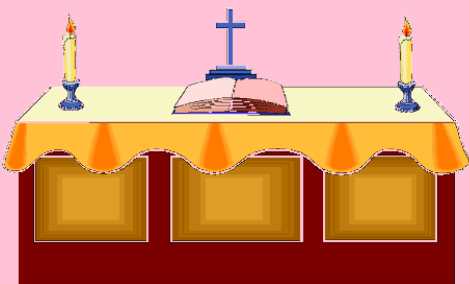

SAINT STANISLAUS, Martyr
(1030 – 1079)
Patron Saint of Poland
Feast day is April 11th



Stanislaus was born of noble parents on July 26, 1030 at Szczepanow near Kraków Poland.

He was ordained there after being educated in the cathedral schools of Gniezno, then capital of Poland and at Paris. He was given a canonry by Bishop Lampert Zula of Cracow, who made him his preacher. He became noted for his preaching and was much sought after as a spiritual adviser. In 1072 he was named Bishop of Cracow.

Later he incurred the enmity of King Boleslaus the Bold when he denounced the King's cruelties and injustices and especially his kidnapping of the beautiful wife of a nobleman. Stanislaus excommunicated the King and stopped services at the Cathedral when Boleslaus entered.

Furious with rage, Boleslaus pursued the saint to the little chapel of St. Michael outside the city, where he was celebrating Mass, and ordered some of his guards to enter and slay him. The men, however, returned saying that they could not kill the saint as he was surrounded by a heavenly light. Upbraiding them for cowardice, the king himself entered the building and murdered the bishop with his own sword. The guards then cut the body into pieces and scattered them abroad to be devoured by beasts of prey. The sacred relics were rescued three days later by the cathedral canons and privately buried at the door of the chapel in which Stanislaus had been slain.

From Pope Francis in the encyclical *Laudato Si* (2015) paragraph 159 / presented by Social Justice Ministry of C-IHM

Since the world has been given to us, we can no longer view reality in a purely utilitarian way, in which efficiency and productivity are entirely geared to our individual benefit. Intergenerational solidarity is not optional, but rather a basic question of justice, since the world we have received also belongs to those who will follow us. The Portuguese bishops have called upon us to acknowledge this obligation of justice: "The environment is part of a logic of receptivity. It is on loan to each generation, which must then hand it on to the next". An integral ecology is marked by this broader vision.
