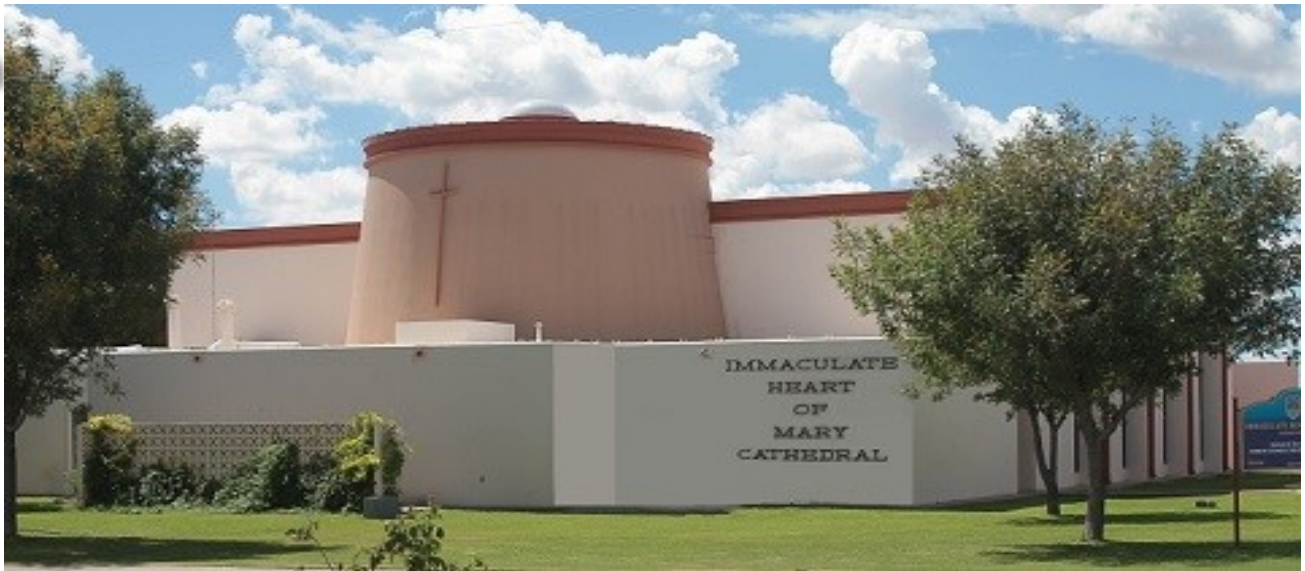

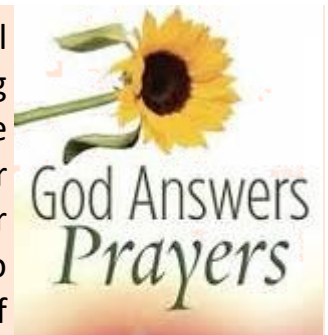

SAINT ATHANASIUS,
Bishop and Doctor
(295-373)
Feast day is May 2nd



St. Athanasius was the great champion of the Faith against the widespread heresy of Arianism, which was the teaching by Arius that Jesus was not truly divine.

Athanasius was given a classical education and became secretary to Alexander, the bishop of Alexandria. Athanasius entered the priesthood and was named the successor of Alexander and he continued

the fight against Arianism, as Alexander had done. In 313, he succeeded Achillas in the Patriarchal See, and two years later he went to the desert to spend some time in retreat with St. Anthony. People called him the "Black Dwarf" because he was short, with dark Egyptian skin. He had plenty of enemies. He defended the true faith for his flock, regardless of the cost to himself. His refusal to tolerate the Arian heresy was the cause of many trials and persecutions for St. Athanasius. He was exiled five times by four Roman emperors, spending 17 of the 45 years he served as bishop of Alexandria in exile. But after a life of virtue and suffering, this intrepid champion of the Catholic Faith, the greatest man of his time, died in peace on May 2, 373. But in the end, it was Athanasius's writings that shaped the future of the church. Among his ascetical writings, his *Life of St. Anthony* (January 17) achieved astonishing popularity and contributed to the establishment of monastic life throughout the Western Christian world.
