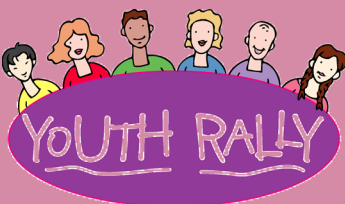

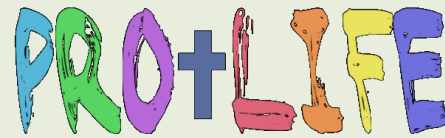
Youth Rally

SAINT IVO OF KERMARTIN, T.O.S.F.

(1253 – 1303)

Patron Saint of Lawyers

Feast Day – May 19th



St. Ivo (Yves) left his father's manor in Kermartin at age 14 to study theology, philosophy and canon law in Paris. He then studied civil law in Orleans. As a student, Ivo began fasting on bread and water during certain parts of the year, wearing a hair shirt and sleeping on a straw mat

with a stone or book for a pillow.

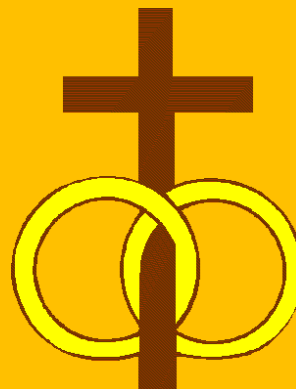
He became an "official" first in Rennes and then in Trèguier. In this capacity, he judged ecclesiastical court cases; this gave him an opportunity to aid orphans and the poor. He acted with impartiality, justice and kindness so that while he was known as "the poor man's advocate," even the losing side respected him and his decisions. Ivo encouraged people to be reconciled outside of court, and he refused to accept bribes. He also paid the expenses of many out of his own pocket, pleaded on their behalf in other courts and visited the imprisoned. After becoming a priest in 1284, he served at a parish in Trédrez, but soon moved to Lovanec. There he was a successful preacher, and he tended the sick in a hospital which he had built.

Ivo was canonized in June 1347 by Clement VI at the urging of Philip I, Duke of Burgundy. At the inquest into his sanctity in 1331, many of his parishioners testified as to his goodness and that he preached regularly in both chapel and field.

We see this in the crisis of family and social ties and the difficulties of recognizing the other. Parents can be prone to impulsive and wasteful consumption, which then affects their children who find it increasingly difficult to acquire a home of their own and build a family.
