Hearing Assistance Available Is it hard for you to hear in the Cathedral because of all the reverberation and echo? Do you wear hearing aids?

The Cathedral now has Hearing Assistance devices available. The receivers cost \$80 and you will own your device.

If you are not sure if they will work for you, you can try one out. To obtain a hearing device please call the parish office at (575) 524-8563.

For those with hearing aids, you need to have a tCoil active in your hearing aids. Not sure what that is? Ask for a receiver with a neck loop. If the tCoil is active, then you will hear directly through your hearing aids. If not, a local audiologist has agreed to activate it (if your hearing aids are equipped with it) for free. We just need your name and phone number and they will call you to set up an appointment.



SAINT PHILIP NERI (1515 – 1595) Patron Saint of Rome Feast Day – May 26th



St. Philip was born in Florence in 1515, the very same year that St. Teresa was born at Avila in Spain. From his sixth year he was characterized by the most perfect obedience toward his parents.

On the eve of Pentecost in 1544, St Philip Neri was praying for the gifts of the Holy

Spirit with great fervor when what appeared to be a ball of fire entered his mouth and caused his heart to become visibly enlarged. He was so violently consumed with divine love that at times he found it necessary to open his garment to obtain relief from the heat emanating from his heart.

A native of Florence, St. Philip had left a life of business to go to Rome, though he had no plans and no money. After living a solitary life of prayer for two years, He studied theology and philosophy, but quite suddenly he quit his studies and devoted himself to rousing the lukewarm people of Rome to the love of Jesus. To this end, he founded confraternities. popularized devotions and established a hospital. Ordained in 1552, he spent several hours a day reconciling penitents to God in the confessional. He conducted informal spiritual discussions, to which people flocked, and founded the Congregation of the Oratory (Oratorians). Known for his great joy, he was sought by laymen and cardinals alike for spiritual refreshment. Philip is called the Apostle of Rome.

Es difícil para que usted pueda escuchar en la catedral debido a el ruido y el eco? Usa aparato para escuchar bien? La catedral tiene ahora asistencia de dispositivos de audición disponibles. Los receptores cuestan \$ 80 y usted será dueño de su dispositivo.

Si no está seguro que va a trabajar para usted, puede probar uno. Para obtener un receptor auditivo por favor llame a la oficina de la iglesia al (575) 524-8563. Para las personas con audífonos, es necesario tener un tCoil activo en sus audífonos. No está seguro de lo que es? Pida un receptor con un lazo del cuello. Si el tCoil está activo, entonces escuchará directamente a través de sus audífonos. Si no, un audiólogo ha acordado activarlo (si los audífonos están equipados con ello) de forma gratuita. Sólo necesitamos su nombre y número de teléfono y ellos le llamarán para hacer una cita.
