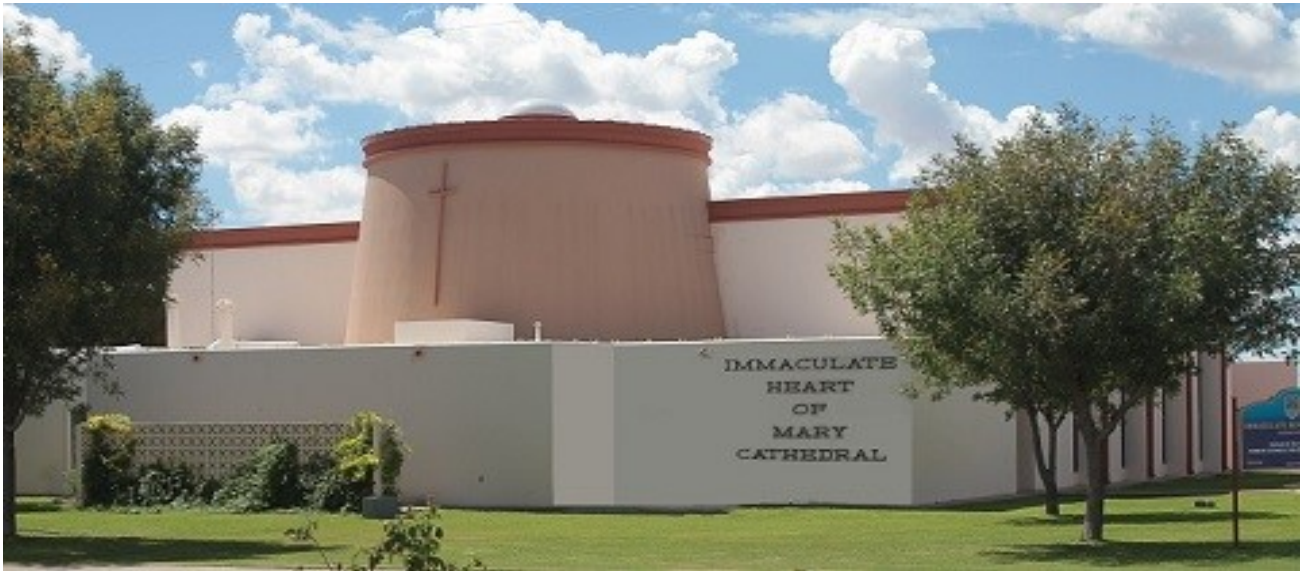

The fourth annual Diocesan Eucharistic Congress will be held on Saturday, August 5 in Deming, NM with events of the Congress being held at both St. Ann Parish and Holy Family Parish.

The theme for the 2017 Congress is the Family. Internationally known speakers Dr. Ricardo and Lucia Luzando will give the keynote address. The day will begin with Bishop Cantú celebrating Mass followed a Eucharistic procession. There will also be breakout sessions, a youth track and a children's track. Congress is an opportunity for the Catholic Church of southern New Mexico to gather together, Bishop, clergy, religious, and laity in a witness to our faith.

## SAINT CAMILLUS de LELLIS

(1550 -1614)

Patron Saint of the Sick and Nurses

Feast day - July 18th



**St. Camillus De Lellis**

Camillus de Lellis was a soldier who fought against the Turks when he was 17. After contracting a disease on his leg, he became both a patient and an orderly at San Giacomo hospital in Rome, but was forced to leave due to his quarrelsome behavior. Because of his gambling habit, by the age of 24, St. Camillus had lost all his possessions.

He worked on the construction of Capuchin buildings in Manfredonia, where the friars helped him along in a gradual conversion. He went back to San Giacomo and served the sick with such charity that he was made superintendent. A widespread practice at that time was to hire anyone willing to attend the sick, even criminals.

St. Camillus left San Giacomo and formed a group of attendants motivated by charity, and under St. Philip Neri's guidance, he was ordained. The Ministers of the Sick, as his congregation was called, opened hospitals throughout Italy; the members aided the sick without distinction, including prisoners and those afflicted with the plague and wounded soldiers. They tended all people including those with deadly diseases. They formed the first recorded 'military field ambulance' to serve the dying during the fighting with Hungary and Croatia. St Camillus' congregation became a religious order in 1591. Camillus died in 1614, and was declared the patron of the sick by Pope Leo XIII in 1746.
